Mike Clark is a Corporate Fellow who leads the x86 core roadmap for AMD. He graduated from the University of Illinois in 1993 with a B.S. in computer engineering and started work on the K5 processor for AMD. Since then, he has worked on every x86 core that AMD has produced, from K7 to the Zen family.

Clark was a co-architect on the extension of the x86 architecture to 64 bits, known as AMD-64, and has several patents that were fundamental to the extension's success. He was also a co-architect of AMD's virtualization solution known as AMD-V. Clark has 30 patents granted in computer architecture. He also received his master's degree in computer engineering from the University of Texas in 2003 while working at AMD.
